## Fun and Games

Barbara Rainey idea for an obstacle course (listening out for the voice of the Holy Spirit)



Create a simple obstacle course in a large room or outside in a safe space. Blindfold a volunteer who then has to find their way across the room or space by listening to your voice calling directions: turn right, stop, take two steps left, etc. The blindfolded person has to listen carefully to your voice or he/she will trip or bump into things. Afterwards, talk about how this is like listening to the Holy Spirit's voice.

To further illustrate this for the next person's turn in the obstacle course, have another person call directions at the same time. Then, for a third volunteer, have two other voices. This teaches a very practical lesson in learning to follow one voice as opposed to many other voices that might influence our lives.
